Q8 Which of the following best describes your current relationship status?



Q9 If you have a partner or spouse, is that person affiliated with TUCW?



Q10 How would you describe your primary racial/ethnic background?



Q16 Which of the following belief systems most closely align with what you believe? (please check at least one and no more than three)





Q22 Congregation's comfort with calling a minister who is: (5 means very comfortable, 0 means not comfortable)








